#### IMAGE REGULATIONS

##### Electronic Submissions

- Photographs should be submitted in jpeg format in a 2 x 3 ratio, with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi. Images outside these specifications will not be accepted
- Maximum size per jpeg image submitted is 10MB. Larger images will also be accepted providing the file is compressed to a maximum of 10MB before submission
- Winners may be requested to submit jpeg images of higher resolution for the purposes of reproduction in publications or at exhibitions

#### JUDGING

Entries will be judged in the last week of October 2009 on the following criteria:

- ▶ technical quality
- ▶ creative vision
- ▶ shot composition
- ▶ rarity of image
- ▶ visual impact
- ▶ appropriateness of image

THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL.

#### SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

- ▶ All submissions must include the location of the shoot, as well as a brief description of the participant in 30 (minimum) to 50 (maximum) words
- ▶ Participants must provide one valid email address and two valid telephone numbers including a cell phone number with their entries
- ▶ Electronic images may be submitted on CD, DVD or flash drive, or via email
- ▶ Submitted images and storage media will not be returned

#### ELIGIBILITY

- This competition is open to amateur photographers only [amateur - a person who engages in a particular activity on an unpaid basis, a non-professional]
- There is no age restriction to entering this competition
- Employees of ImageWorks Consulting Limited, competition judges and the immediate family members of both are prohibited from entering this competition

#### RULES

- Photographs must be of birds native to Trinidad and Tobago Entries featuring non-native birds will not be judged
- Images of birds in captivity - i.e. in cages or at the zoo - will NOT be accepted
- Where birds are perched on human hands for the purpose of taking the shoot, the image submitted must not show the hand
- Persons can submit more than one entry providing that each submission is accompanied by a completed registration form (see form below)
- Participants must possess the exclusive rights to each submitted work and are responsible for obtaining any necessary permission relating to the subject captured
- Winning entries become the property of EOG Resources Trinidad Limited. Through submission of print or electronic images, participants (and their legal guardians where applicable) grant non-exclusive reproduction and publication rights to the works submitted to EOG Resources Trinidad Limited and its affiliates for promotional and exhibition purposes, which will not be returned

#### Print Submissions

- Photographs submitted must be 8" x 10" minimum

#### PRIZES

Twelve winners will be selected - one for each month of the year - including an overall winner.
